

CaSTL Center Engage Families at O. C. Black History Cultural Faire

The CaSTL Center (Chemistry at the Space Time Limit) hosted a hands-on science booth at the 37th Annual Orange County Black History Parade and Cultural Faire in Anaheim on Saturday, February 4, 2017.
